



## ENF HIGH IMPACT ACTION PROCESS

- Topic Upgrading the forest based value chain
- Direct Beneficiaries: SMEs
- Joint initiative of the companies who co-develop together with 1–2 service providers from 2 or more ENF regions
- Vouchers 40 200-45 000€, available fund 279 000€
- 80 % support,
  20 % (in-kind, e.g. salaries)
- Focus is on new or better solutions(s) for a specific end-user, in real industrial environment (somewhere in ENF, but can be upscale later on and exported)
- Integration with other existing projects is recommended

#### Educational solutions, international networking and regional appeal

A diverse range of educational opportunities and workforce drawn from other regions increase the regional expertise level and promote international business, creating added value for regional development.



## HIA pilot - What happens next?

- Selected HIA applications are so-called "HIA sub-grantees"
- Cost are eligible between 1<sup>st</sup> December 2019 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020
- The Regional Council of Lapland continues communication with each lead partner in order to make financing decision – in progress
- Pilots are paid in in 3 parts:
  - pre-financing max 30% after financing decisions
  - interim payment 30% after progress reporting approved by the EC reporting period until 28.2.2018 -
  - final payment after final delivery of the project results and approved by the EC –reporting period for the HIA pilots 1.3-30.6.2020



## HIA pilot - What happens next?

- HIA pilots will come together:
  - Kick-off the pilots 11.12.2019 Helsinki
  - Development of the pilots week 13, March 2020, Helsinki aiming to report the progress of the each pilots and to share first hand experiences
  - Lessons learned and deliverables of the pilots week 35, August 2020, Oulu
- Pilots will be instructed to provide mid term and final reports will follow the EC instructions and format given to the Regional Council of Lapland
